# Types of contributions

- Full papers (up to 14 pages)
- Short papers (up to 8 pages)
- Special session proposals

# **Publication**

- All accepted and presented contributions (excepting poster sessions) will be submitted for inclusion in a Springer LNBIP volume.

Annual conference proceedings of ICDEC are available in IEEE Xplore for 2016, and from 2017 to 2024 in the digital library of Springer.

- Selected papers may be considered for publication in special or regular issues of partner journals.

# Submission and paper selection

- Researchers are invited to submit scientific papers related to emerging technologies and business innovation.

Submitted papers are selected based on their originality, relevance to the conference topics and scientific quality, and following a double blind peer-reviewing process.

- At least, one of the authors of an accepted submission should attend the conference to present the contribution.
- Papers should be anonymous and submitted in PDF format through the EasyChair system. English is the only accepted language for writing and presenting papers.
